



## Here are ways to help your child practice skills while having fun!

Day 1

#### **Read Together**

#### **Read Together**

Have your child read Decodable Story *Little Rob*. Find words that have short o.

Day 3

#### /o/ Spelled Oo

Have your child fill in the blanks with the letter *o*. Then have your child find the three rhyming words.

Day 4

#### **Meaningful Word Groups**
