



Talking About Helping Each Other

Learning About Letter Recognition Setting

Here are ways to help your child practice skills while having fun!

Day 1

Read Together

Write the letters Ff, Gg, Hh, Ii, Jj, Kk, Ll, Mm, and Nn on cards. Show a card and have your child name the letter. Continue with other cards. Then have your child point to and name letters in the Name the letters activity.

Day 2

Read Together

Have your child read Decodable Story $Am\ I$? Find words that begin with the letters Ff, Gg, Hh, Ii, Jj, Kk, Ll, Mm, or Nn.

Day 3

Rhyming Words

Draw a picture of a cat. Help your child make rhyming words by changing the beginning sound. Possible words are *bat*, *fat*, *hat*, *mat*, *pat*, *rat*, and *sat*.

Day 4

Names

Write names for friends or story characters in a list. Help your child say the names on the list and then tell something about that person.

Day 5

Practice Handwriting

Have your child practice writing words for the letters Ff through Nn.
