

Talking About Nature

Learning About /s/ Spelled Ss Setting

Here are ways to help your child practice skills while having fun!

Day 1

Read Together

Ask your child to pretend that you are at the beach together. Have him or her name items you would find at the beach that begin with /s/, such as *sun*, *sand*, *sunglasses*, *sandwiches*, and *sailboat*.

Day 2

Read Together

Have your child read Decodable Story *Sock Sack*. Find /s/ words.

Day 3

/s/ Spelled Ss

Review the words that begin with s. Write at on a piece of paper. Have your child add the letter s and say the new word. Write am. Have your child add the letter s and say the new word. Tell your child that sam is a name so it needs an uppercase s.

Day 4

Proper Nouns

Have your child say his or her name. Ask what school your child goes to. Ask your child the teacher's name. Ask for a friend's name. Tell your child that nouns that name specific people and places begin with uppercase letters.

Day 5

Practice Handwriting

Have your child write his or her name. Check that the letters are formed correctly and that beginning capital letters are used. Words to talk about
