

Here are ways to help your child practice skills while having fun!

Day 1

Read Together

Write the letters *Aa*, *Bb*, *Cc*, *Dd*, and *Ee* on strips of paper. Name each letter for your child. Then place the letter strips in a bag. Have your child take a strip and name the letter.

Day 2

Read Together

Have your child read Decodable Story *I Am!* Find words that begin with the letters *Aa*, *Bb*, *Cc*, *Dd*, or *Ee*.

Day 3

The Letters Aa to Ee

Point to one of the letters in the Name the letters activity and have your child name the letter and the picture. Continue with each of the letters and pictures.

Day 4

Use Names

Write the names of family members and relatives in a list and read the names with your child. Then give a clue describing one of the people and have your child name the person.

Day 5

Practice Handwriting

Have your child practice writing the following words for the letters Aa to Ee.
